An Affordable Airplane Stand

A styrofoam cooler works great for an airplane cradle. Just cut out an appropriate sized notch out of each end to nest the fuselage into. For added stability, put some weight in the bottom like fish tank gravel, sack of flour, etc. Screws, t-pins, x-acto knives etc. can be stuck into the foam for storage. The bottom can hold larger objects. The top can be used as a tool tray. There may also be room for a cool glass of iced tea. And all for a buck or two!

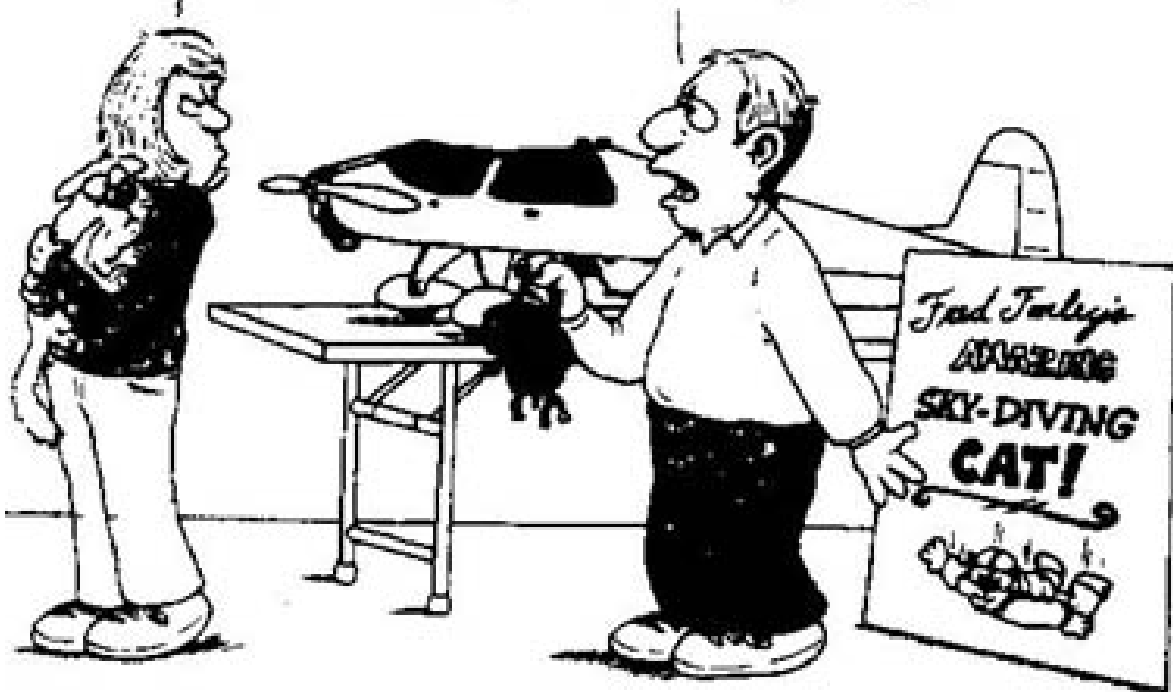
