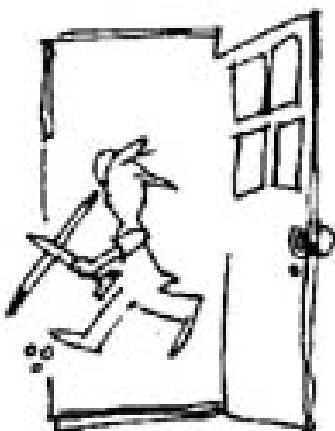

Weedeater Repair– for what it’s worth:

We had an interesting problem with our weedeater at the field this summer. I’ve experienced it twice before, once on our machine and another time on another weedeater. When trying to start it, it pulled over with good compression but wouldn’t even fire. It sounded unusually quiet. Having experienced the problem before, the solution took less than a minute. The mud wasps had made a nest in the muffler, completely blocking it off. If the exhaust can’t get out of the cylinder, fuel can’t get in and it won’t run. It’s just like sticking a potato in the tailpipe of a car. Shoving a screwdriver in to knock the nest out was all it took to fix it. A guy I work with had this happen to him. He took his machine to a shop and they sold him a new muffler! I guess the size of the passages in engines of this size are just right for the little critters to build their nests. This could also be a problem on models that are stored in garages, especially gas powered ones. It’s nice when the solutions are simple.

Christmas Suggestion:

Real Flight has done it again. They always manage to come up with something new just before Christmas. I suspect it is intentional. This year, they are releasing G3 which promises better graphics. In this version, when you damage your aircraft, you can see the damage. There will be an upgrade program available for those with G2.
