President's Message:

Thank you, thank you! A lot of good things were accomplished in January. This is because of the efforts of many club members. This is a great group of people who can always be counted on for help when it is needed.

- The big news from January is the success of the 10th annual model forum. The event ran very smoothly thanks to the efforts of many people. Thanks to everyone who helped in the set up and take down and thanks to everyone who helped during the day at the sign in table, especially Al Metz. We took in \$1135.00 total, of which about \$490.00 was in raffle tickets. That means about 171 people attended. 28 pilots flew their electric aircraft throughout the day and there were over 40 static display models which is more than we've had at any other forum so far. We will be having a follow up meeting to discuss the good and the bad so that we can improve the event for next year. Each of the 3 clubs will take a small amount of the profits and the rest will be donated to the school. The school PTO was in charge of the food. It looked like they did a pretty good business. There was quite a line at lunch time. A very special thanks to Linda and John Spencer for making this facility available to us!
- We sold off all of Doc Schwarz's stuff at the STARS auction with the exception of the giant scale Stevens Acro. Our half of the sale was \$102.00 after paying the commission.

 - We were invited to attend the EAA meeting at the airfield. Don Perricone is doing a good job of getting all of the groups at the airfield together. He provides free donuts at the meetings. This will draw anywhere from 150 to 400 scouts who will be camping there from Friday evening, May 19th thru Sunday morning, the 21st. On the 20th there will be all kinds of aviation related activities including the ARCS doing buddy-box flying with the scouts. I will provide details as they become available. The other item is the Fathers day pancake breakfast. It is hoped that this tradition will continue but right now the EAA needs someone to be in charge of it. If anyone is interested, talk to me or Don Perricone. They will also be looking for a commitment for workers on the event. If they can't get these 2 things the breakfast will be called off. 

Winter Field Use Policy:

You can fly during the winter *at our field, not from the main hangar*. The airport must still be considered active even though the runways have snow on them. You *may not* drive down to the field. It is not a matter of your 4 wheel drive being able to make it down there without getting stuck, it is a matter of damage to the road. Road maintenance is one of our biggest expenses and with a little care and discretion, we can keep those costs down to a reasonable level. Driving across the runways is forbidden just like in the summer. The best bet is to park at the main hangar and carry your stuff down to the field. It's not that hard and if you bring a little plastic sled along it will be quite easy. Feel free to enjoy the field year round but you must comply with these rules.
