- The AMA now recommends that we register our UAS's with the FAA. They will continue to try to negotiate with the FAA to try to simplify the process but for now we must comply with the law. The deadline for registering is Feb 19th. This can be done online at <https://www.faa.gov/uas/>. For those who don't have internet access, it may be best if you get together with someone who does so that they can help you. I've been told you can register by paper but the only thing I can find relates to large aircraft, not small UAS's.
- The club's policy on FAA registration will be one of 100% compliance, ***no exceptions!*** In order to fly at our field you must have registered, you must have your certificate with you and you must have your aircraft properly labeled. Of course, your AMA and club membership must be up to date too. We will be checking to be sure everyone is in compliance. Sorry it has to be like this but we can't take the chance of getting kicked out of our field because someone isn't following the rules.
- Elections of officers will happen at the March meeting. At the present time the slate of candidates is Herb Ziegler– President, Phil Artese– VP, Al Metz– Secretary and Kevin Kiniry– Treasurer. Anyone interested in run-


