- In an effort to potentially save a life, we purchased an AED (Automatic Electric Defibrillator). It will reside in the impound shed until the weather gets cold, at which point I will store it at my house. There are periodic tests that need to be done to it. Training for its use will be in 2 stages. There is an instructional DVD that I've copied and is being circulated to club members. I'll have more copies at the meeting. Secondly, I have looked into AED/CPR training. There is a place in B'ville that will provide training for \$40.00 per person. We will take a count at the meeting and I'll set that up. With or without the AED, the training is highly recommended. You may even save a loved one with the knowledge you get here. I strongly encourage it. (They don't teach rescue breathing any more so you don't have to be turned off about that.)
- We're looking into the availability of the Syracuse Academy of Science for the forum again this year. I'll keep you posted.
