Please help out if at all possible!** The preliminary workload is significantly less than in previous years since we have our own chairs now. I think we can set up the dining area and cooking area on Saturday the 15th instead of Friday. That way the airplanes don't have to move out of the hangar until Saturday.

Volunteer tasks:

The week before:

- Put out the signs.

Friday:

- Need about 4 people to help pick up tables, sausage, etc.

Saturday: 8AM to noon or so

- Need Airplanes moved out of hangar- early morning
- Clean floor (pressure wash/sweep)
- Lay down cardboard and position griddles, set up cooking area.
- Set-up tables, chairs, and cover tables
- Set up EZ-Ups
- Pick up food from Nojaim's
- Lay out barriers, parking area.

Sunday: 6AM to 1PM

- **Need lots of help for food prep, cooking, serving, busing tables, emptying trash, parking, etc.**
- Clean up after the event
- Returning unused food to Nojaim's
- Take down EZ-Ups and parking barricades
- Take down tables and chairs
- Retrieve signs

Monday: 9AM to noon

- Return FD griddle, tables

Tuesday: 8AM to 10AM

- Need a couple of people to take trash to the dump.

Status so far is:

- Health permit and insurance are done
- Paper products, cups, plastic ware, etc have been ordered and received.
- Gianelli Sausage and Nojaim's have been contacted. Arrangements have been made.
- Tables will be borrowed from Walt's hobby and Warners Church
- Marcellus FD will allow us to borrow the round griddle again.
- Propane has been donated by Glider oil. All tanks have been filled. This saved us \$128.44.
- Matheison Portable toilets will provide porta-pottys and a wash station.

Regarding the trash, Jack Haggerty has offered to collect the trash in his trailer and take it to the Skaneateles transfer station on the following Tuesday. This will save us over \$200.00.

In the next week or so I will clean and start the refrigerators to be sure they all work.
