President's Message:

This event will be combined with the CIA indoor flying club. Thanks to Nelson Pardee and Mark Ferry for graciously offering their facility!

The food will be Italian type (Ziti, Salad, Pizza, Wings).

The cost will be \$10.00 per person, under 12 will be free.

The church is on West Genesee St about .4 miles east of West Genesee High School, on the right. Enter through the white double doors on the west side, not the glass doors in the main entrance.

Pull into the parking lot on the west side of the building (next to the dentist's office, NOT the cemetery side). Straight back, on the left, enter the white double doors. You can enter on the east side, but will need to pull around the building.

Other News:

- The AMA Ballots are in. Rich Hanson (the incumbent) has won.
- The EAA/AMA Young Eagles Build and Fly Program is taking shape. At this point there are 15 interested students at the Junior and Senior High level in Marcellus. We have ordered the airplane kit and have received some of the materials. Construction will begin in January with the goal of having the airplane done by flying season. I will keep you updated.
- FAA has announced a new requirement for recreational UAS operation. There will be a test that we have to pass. This test is not available yet. I went online to renew my FAA registration and my account showed that it no longer expires at the end of the year but it now runs until 12/12/2020. I'm sure they extended it to give them time to develop this test. Here is a list of the requirements for recreational UAS flying:

To fly under The Exception for Recreational Flyers, you must:

1. Register your drone
 2. Fly only for recreational purposes
 3. Follow the safety guidelines of a community based organization
 4. Keep your drone within the visual line of sight or use a visual observer
 5. Give way and do not interfere with any manned aircraft
 6. Get prior authorization before operating in controlled airspace
 7. Fly at or below 400' in uncontrolled airspace
 8. Comply with all airspace restrictions
 9. **Pass an aeronautical knowledge and safety test– Not available yet**
- Planning has begun for the model forum. We are shooting for March 7th but may get pushed back a week due to the sports schedule at the school. The forum committee agrees that we should bring back informational talks and seminars so we will be working toward that.
 - The STARS are hosting a First Day of Winter Fun Fly on Saturday Dec 21 from 11 to 4. See below.
 - Don't forget our annual NYD fun fly on Wed, Jan 1st. We'll be in the newly renovated airport lounge. Please bring a small dish to pass. The club will provide burgers and dogs.
 - Mark your calendars for the annual STARS auction. It is on Jan 24th starting at 5PM at Walt's Hobbytown.
